Title: Professional Trainer

Julio Reyes' playing career spanned 14 years from 1988-2002.

Julio began his playing career at Alianza Lima of Peru until he moved with his family to Panama in 1989. He played professionally in Peru as well for the Panama Euro Kickers F.C. and participated in two **CONCACAF Championship Cups**.

He then moved to the U.S. and played for the Staten Island Vipers and the NJ Stallions before retiring. Julio began his new career as a professional trainer in 1997. He trained local clubs before assuming the role of assistant coach and for the NJ Stallions in 2004. He currently holds a USSF License. In December of 2007, Julio completed an international training course, sanctioned by the Spanish Soccer Federation at the world's most famous soccer club, Real Madrid.

Maximo Reyes' international professional playing career spanned over 17 years.

He reached the highest level of a professional athlete by playing for his country, The Peruvian National Team. Maximo started his professional career at the famed club Alianza Lima of Peru. He later moved to Venezuela and continued to enjoy a stellar career by playing for Estudiantes de Merida, Deportivo Italia and Deportivo Tachira. Maximo also played in the **Copa Libertadores** on four occasions during his extended playing career. Maximo currently holds a USSF License.
