Tactical Training– Every drill, every exercise and every session focuses on how we play at Southwest Baptist University. We work towards developing our team to be very attack-minded and possession oriented.

We want to possess the ball in our opponents half and we want to create 20-25 shots every game. We focus on developing an attacking mentality in all of our players.

Physiological Training– Being fit is critical, especially at the college level. You will experience how much faster you must play and how much fitter you need to be to compete at the college level. If you are competitive and love the game, then you will love your experience at this camp.
